

OAKWOOD COUNTRY CLUB POLICY

February 2020

MEMBERSHIP

1. All new membership applications will be turned in to the membership committee chairman.
2. Any membership application received during the off-season will be summarized and mailed to the membership for their input.
3. Prospective members must attend one function. Applicants pending board approval may have guest privileges without charge to the host member until their application has been approved and they have been oriented.
4. Members who join as equity members on the installment plan will receive full privileges upon payment of their initiation fee. Club certificates will not be issued until the equity has been paid in full.
5. Non-equity members do not have a vote and are not eligible to serve on the Board of Trustees.
6. Social members may not exceed 20% of the total membership. They may golf three times per season at no charge. They may not participate in events that require a handicap.
7. A member on demit has no club privileges and may not vote. A member may take more than one year of demit but not in consecutive years. An individual on demit may be a guest of a member for golf or social events combined a total of three times per season. The member assumes expenses for this guest.
8. Members returning from a one year demit are exempt from paying an initiation fee. Members returning beyond the one year demit will pay ½ of the initiation fee.
9. Single individuals have the option of joining with either a Single or Regular Membership. A single member in a committed, non-familial relationship may choose the Single Member/Special Guest Regular Membership Option by naming his/her special guest for the year and paying full Regular dues. This choice will be by written application to the Board for approval. Upon approval, this couple will enjoy all of the advantages of a husband and wife membership. The single member is committed to this option for the year and cannot make a change of special guest during the year, but may revoke their special guest's privileges upon written request to the Board. The single member agrees to be responsible for their special guest's charges. The privileges of the special guest are extended to his/her children under the same criteria as Member children as stated in club rules. The OCC Board has considered some strict definitions of just what a Special Guest is and has decided in favor of a broad policy of trust and expectation. The Board assumes that all single members seeking the Special Guest Option will do so only when they have an established commitment to a long term relationship. The Board presumes that the members really do not want to take advantage of the club's policies; the Board prefers a policy of trust to a policing role.
10. An equity member resigning from Oakwood will receive an equity refund upon club receipt of sufficient new equity monies or may, with written notification to and acceptance of the Board, transfer their equity dollars towards their next year's annual dues thereby extending their club membership by up to one year. The resigning

member will be responsible for all additional fees and taxes to be billed upon Board acceptance at which time they must surrender their equity share certificate.

11. All Oakwood members will be asked to serve on committees for social or golf events. If there is a conflict, the member may trade assignments or remit \$50 to the party chairman.

GOLF

1. Proper golf attire is suggested.
2. Any guest is limited to six plays per season.
3. Single club members opting to pay the Regular Golf Dues will be allowed unlimited golf guests per year at no charge. They may only bring an individual guest six times per season per Golf rule #2 above.
4. Golf guests must be registered by name in the greens fee book in the entrance way.
5. Members unmarried children living at home and under age 21, students up to and including age 25, and members' grandchildren age 12 and under are exempt from greens fees but must be accompanied by a member.
6. Oakwood golf events are for adult members only unless specifically noted otherwise.
7. Men's Day is Wednesday until 4:00 PM; Ladies' Day is Thursday until 4:00 PM.
8. When the "No Carts" sign is posted on the cart barns, only walking is permitted on the course. Violators are subject to a \$25 fine as determined by the Board of Trustees.
9. Oakwood members may bring guests to golf at no charge during our off-season which is November 1 through April 30.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. Any donation to the club must first be presented to the board for approval.
2. No smoking of any kind is permitted in the club house.
3. The rental fee for the club house is \$200; for the club house and golf course \$500. The member must submit the request in writing to the Board of Trustees. If the club house is rented, it is understood that the locker rooms are still available for members' use. Club supplies are not included with the rental, and the facility should be left as found. Any activity involving 12 or more guests requires a club house rental.
4. Members will be charged for meals not canceled by the reservation deadline.
5. Children under five may dine free; children aged five through ten will be charged half-price.
6. The last person leaving the club must lock all five doors and all windows. They must also make sure the fans, lights and air conditioners are turned off.
7. The last golfer on the course is responsible for making sure the cart barns are locked.
8. No club property is to be removed from the premises without the permission of the Board of Trustees.
9. Any guest is limited to six social functions per season.
10. Oakwood will make a \$100 memorial donation in the event of an active member's death.
11. Unless members indicate otherwise to the board secretary, all communication from the board or members, including meeting notices and minutes, may be sent using electronic mail.
